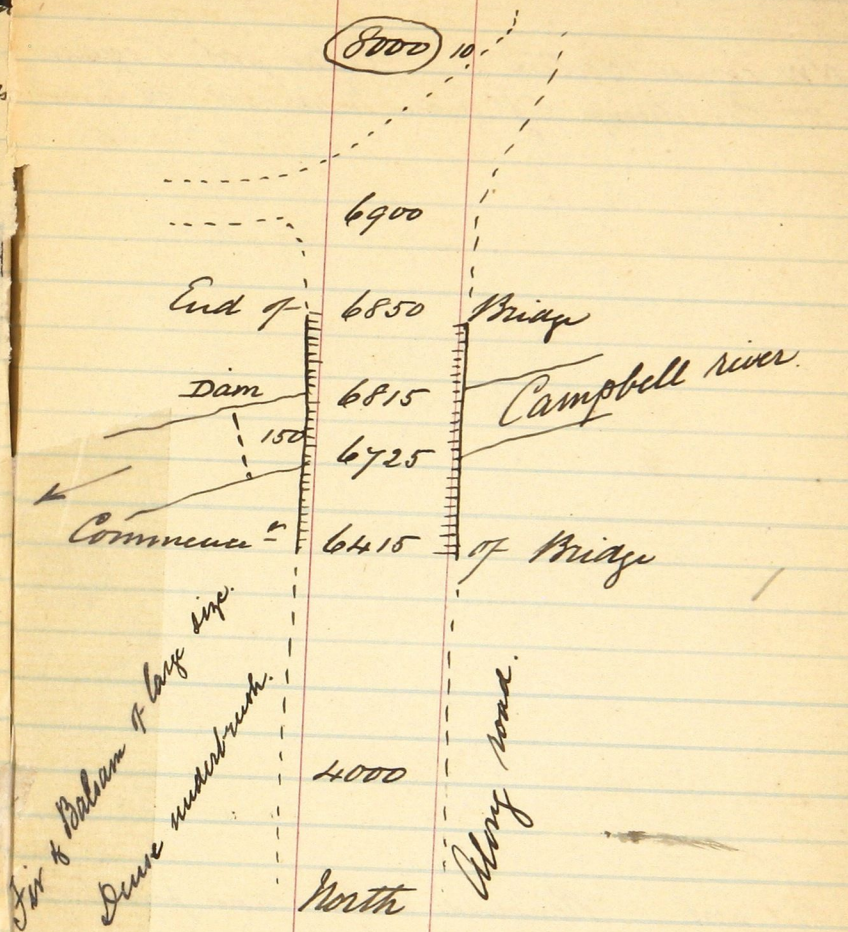

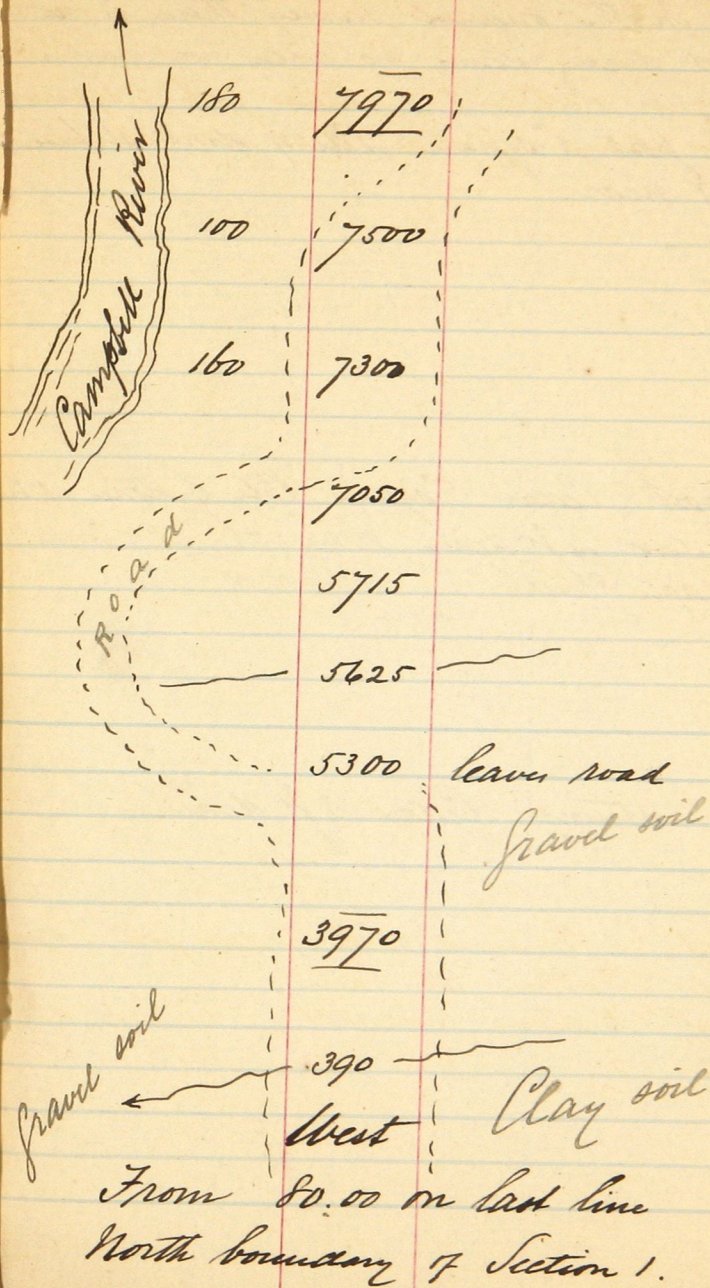


From Iron post on International Boundary line, near the shore of Semiahmoo Bay.

Except during storms no water now reaches within about 2.10 chains of the NW post.

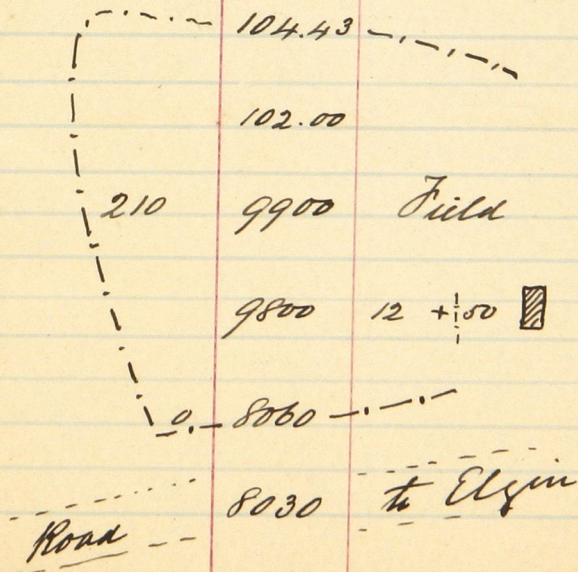

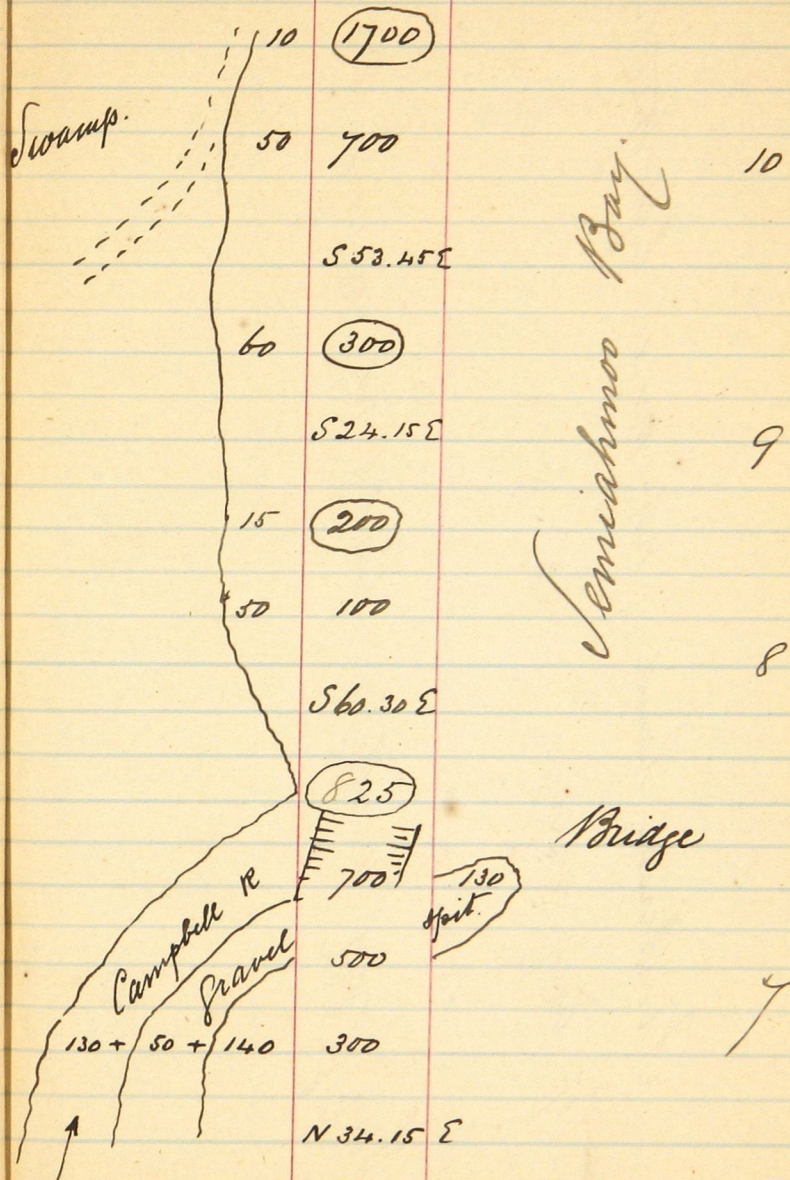

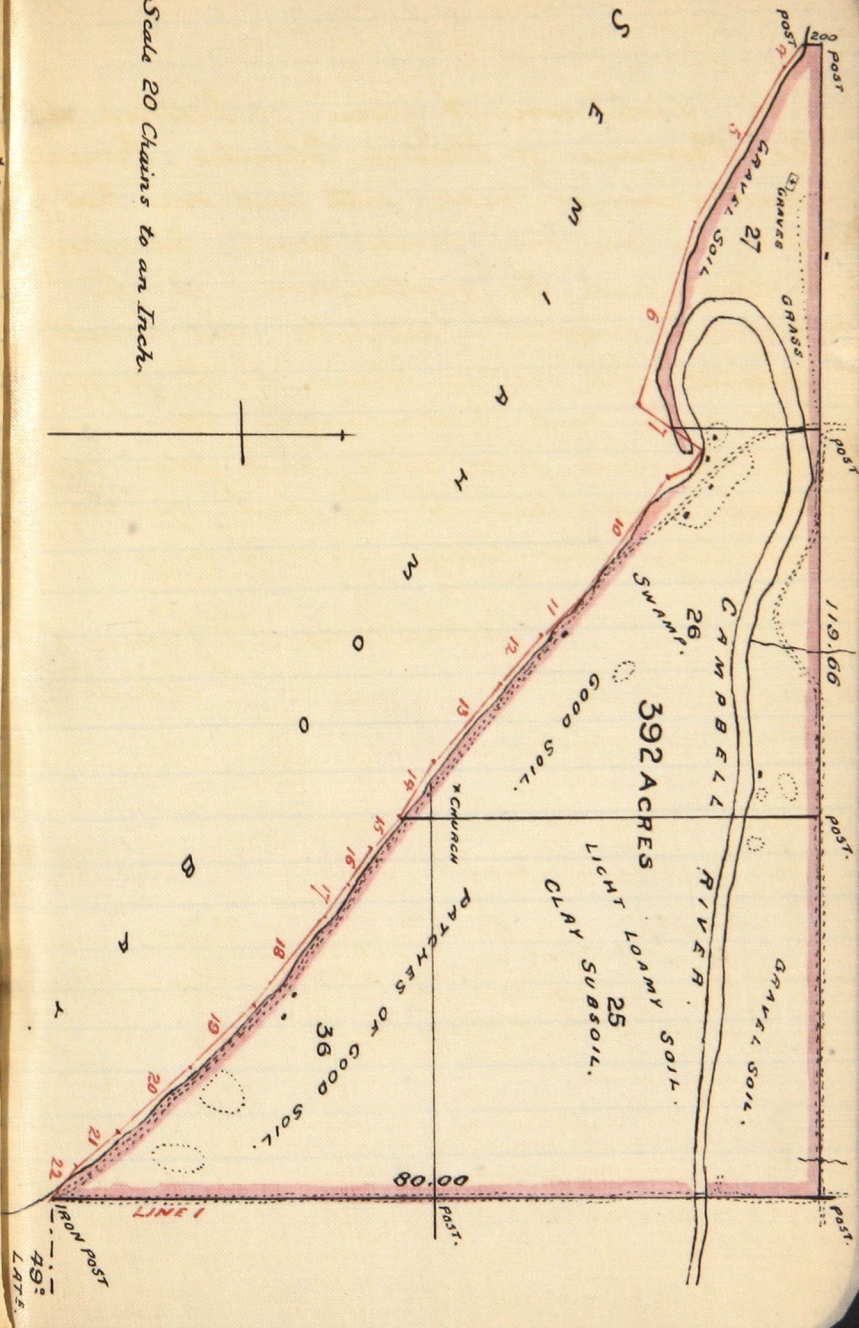
